

## **Addictions Treatment Design for Individuals Living with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder**

This two-day workshop will focus on FASD sensitive considerations in development of prevention strategies and intervention techniques for professionals practicing in addictions prevention, assessment/ treatment, Twelve-Step programs, counseling and/or aftercare. The goals of this seminar are to:

- Update addictions specialists with current medical findings regarding physical issues, learning abilities, sensory processing, and executive functioning challenges within this patient population that may impact addictions and treatment/recovery.
- Provide participants with the **OBD** Triage Addiction Screening and Intervention Tools<sup>®</sup> in order to create individualized, strength-based treatment planning. This is achieved by considering the respective elements of the patient's overall functioning considering their medical disposition, learning style, sensory interferences, trauma, social history, and cultural factors.
- Review individual cases (*strict guidelines of confidentiality applies*), discuss variables in treatment modalities and demonstrate how to enhance existing programs in holistic, creative, patient-specific care with inclusion of natural and motivational supports.

*Space for this session is limited to enrich the learning experience.* Participants must be in attendance both days in order to receive certificate of completion.
