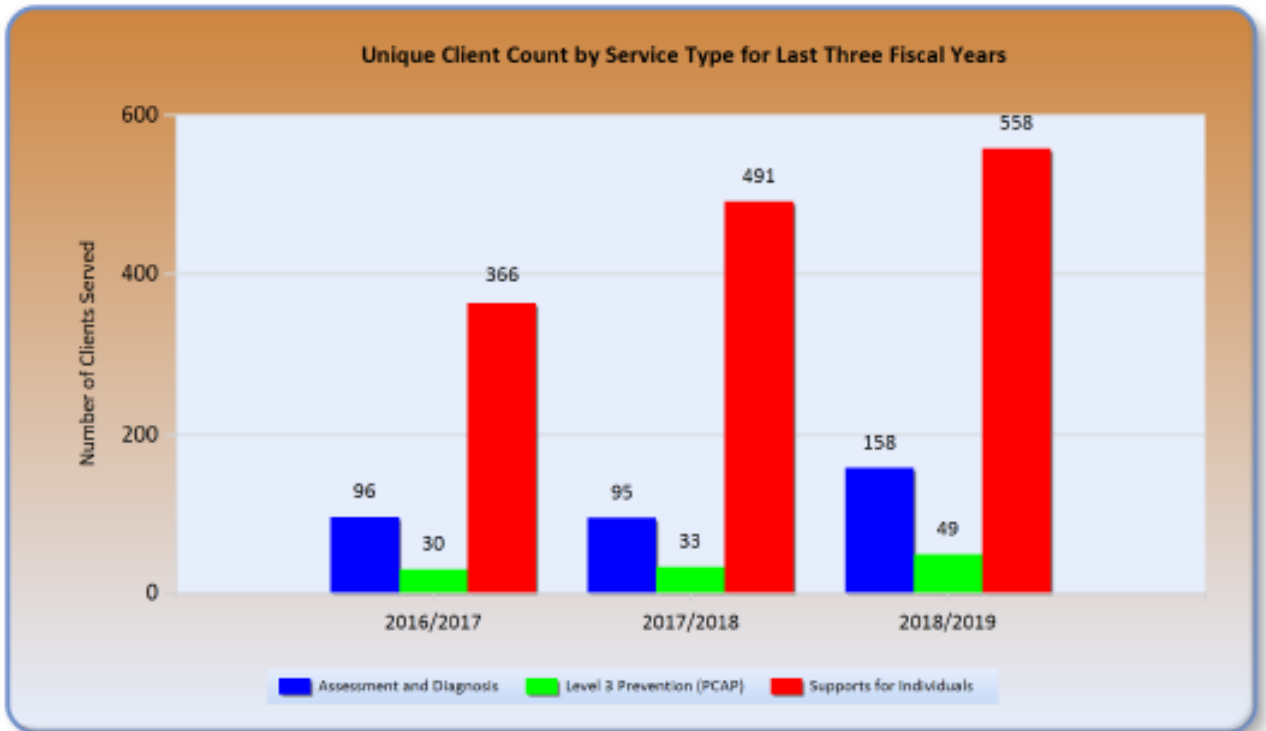
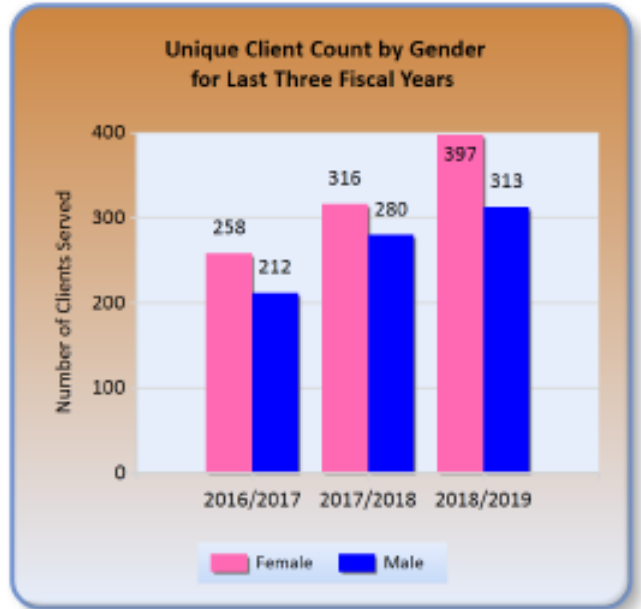
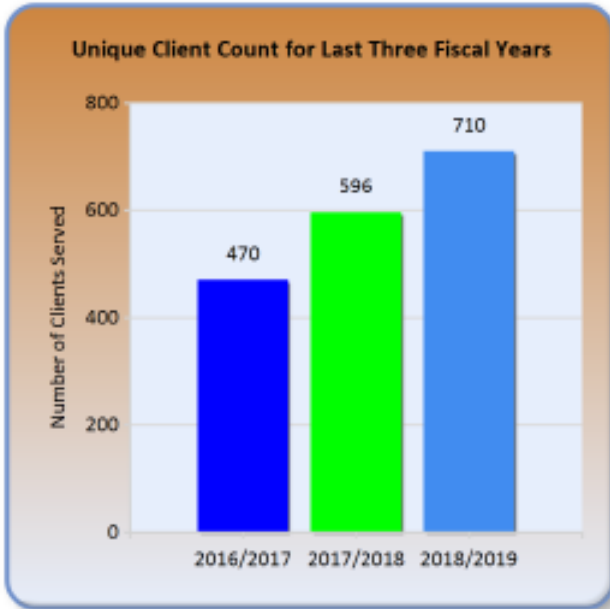

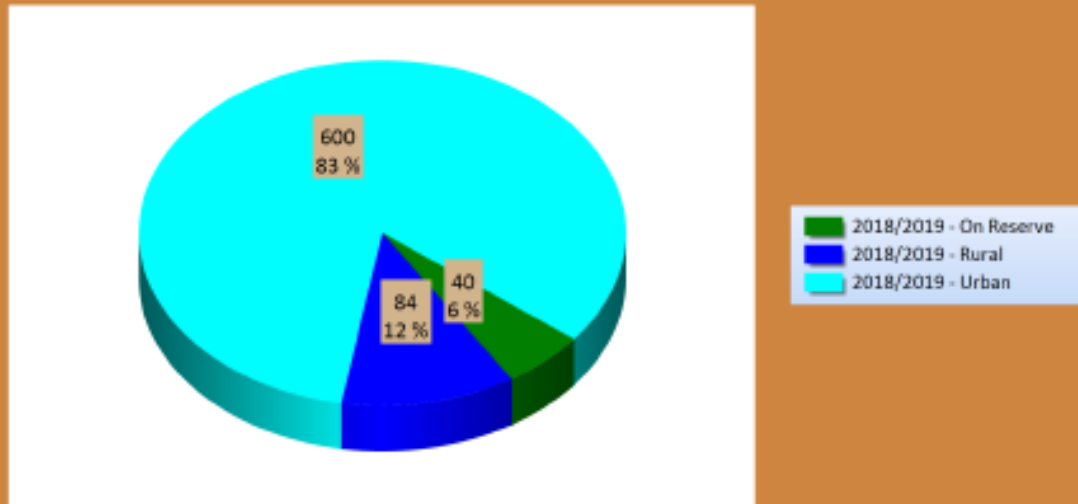
Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) Service Network Program Fact Sheet

Edmonton FASD NETWORK - 2018/2019



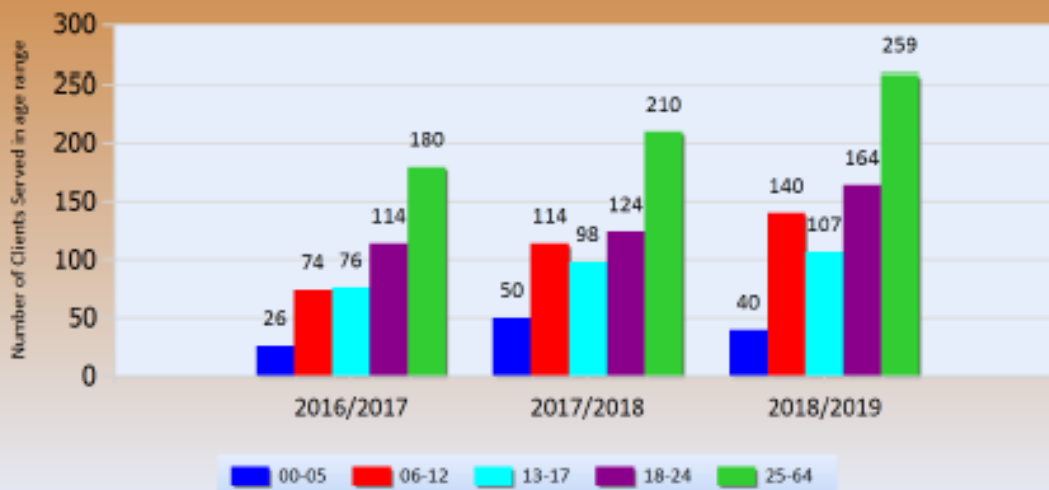
