 <p>I can stay safe and keep the people are me safe by staying healthy. I will tell an adult if I don't feel well.</p>	 <p>I will wash my hands with soap and water. I will scrub my whole hands when I wash.</p>	 <p>I will cover my cough and sneeze so I don't spread my germs.</p>
 <p>I will cough or sneeze into a tissue and then wash my hands.</p>	 <p>If I get sick, I will have to stay home. I keep other people safe by keeping personal space!</p>	 <p>I can be safe to stay healthy and keep the people around me healthy!</p>
