

CASA FASD Parenting Skills Group: FASTRACS

<u>The Group</u>

The Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) Parenting Skills Group is facilitated by the FASTRACS program at CASA.

- It's a FREE short term resource that includes six weeks of FASD parenting skills training, FASD education, information on community resources and peer support.
- FASTRACS does not provide assessment or a diagnosis of FASD.
- Facilitators include a parent with more than 20 years experience, an Occupational Therapist and an Occupational Therapy Assistant.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, groups will be held virtually. Reliable access to a computer, internet, camera and mic is needed.

<u>Who It's For</u>

- Parents/caregivers of children from ages 3 to 12 who are suspected to have or have been diagnosed with FASD
- Families with the ability to actively participate in a group setting and be committed to attending all six sessions
