1. Support for individuals survey

Used by the following programs:

FASS (Bissell), Hope Terrace (Bissell), Indigenous Services (CASA), First Steps (CSS), McDaniel Youth (CSS), Step By Step (CSS), GES (EFRY), Bridges (Leduc), MNA, Open Arms (UP)

Target:

Clients with (or possibly with) FASD receiving support services aged 12 or older and deemed capable of completing the survey.

Protocol:

- Each client will be offered at least one survey per year, preferably two, at strategic points of services such as reviews of service plans.
- Each program should decide on how to best administer their client surveys, based on their agency guidelines.
- There is no expectation for surveys to be anonymous.
- It is OK for either staff members or supervisors to help clients assigned to them with completing the surveys.

2. Support for caregivers survey

Used by the following programs:

FasTracs (CASA), Indigenous Services (CASA), Coaching Families (CSS), FASD Respite (Elves)

Target:

Caregivers of children/dependents with (or possibly with) FASD receiving support services.

Protocol:

- Each caregiver will be offered at least one survey per year, preferably two, at strategic points of services to the person they care for such as reviews of service plans.
- Each program should decide on how to best administer the surveys, based on their agency guidelines.
- There is no expectation for surveys to be anonymous.
- It is OK for either staff members or supervisors to help caregivers with completing the surveys.

3. FASD assessment services – post clinic client survey

Used by the following programs:

Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital or FASD support services

Target:

Clients ages 18 and up who completed an FASD assessment and who are deemed able to complete a survey on their own.

Protocol:

- Each client age 18 and over and deemed able to complete a survey should complete a survey.
- The program will decide on how to best administer the surveys, based on agency guidelines.
- There is no expectation for surveys to be anonymous.
- It is OK for either staff members or supervisors to help clients with completing the surveys.

4. FASD assessment services – post clinic caregiver survey

Used by the following programs:

Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital or FASD support services

Target:

Caregivers of children/dependents with (or possibly with) FASD receiving support services and whose children/dependents completed an FASD assessment.

Protocol:

- Each caregiver will be given the opportunity to complete a survey.
- The program will decide on how to best administer the surveys, based on agency guidelines.
- There is no expectation for surveys to be anonymous.
- It is OK for either staff members or supervisors to help caregivers with completing the surveys.
