WHEREAS, approximately 4 per cent of Canadians live with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD), a complex condition resulting from prenatal alcohol exposure;

AND WHEREAS, despite the prevalence of FASD, stigma continues to affect how it is understood, discussed and whether individuals and families feel safe seeking help;

AND WHEREAS, early identification, intervention and support can make a positive impact and improve outcomes for those living with FASD;

AND WHEREAS, the City of Edmonton recognizes the importance of FASD awareness and prevention, and the role that all Edmontonians have in creating a more informed, supportive and inclusive community;
